# The 8 Foundations of Christian Worship (Pt. 1)

### 1. The Word of God – The Ultimate Foundation

Worship begins with the revelation of who God is, and that revelation comes through the Word of God. Scripture unveils the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, revealing God's nature, His promises, and His eternal plan. The Word is infallible, unwavering truth, a historical record of God's divine work. As we read, meditate, and study, we are compelled to worship—responding in praise, adoration, and thanksgiving for His greatness.

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." – Psalm 119:105





### 2. A Right Relationship with God

True worship is rooted in relationship, not ritual. We were created for worship, and in adoration and reverence, we establish a connection with God. He desires intimacy with His people—a daily communion through Jesus Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit. A right relationship acknowledges His divine attributes—He is everlasting, almighty, sovereign, redeemer, and holy. Worship flows from knowing Him personally and walking in His presence daily.

### 3. Belief in Jesus Christ
